6. RIDERS

Participation at this meeting is restricted to the holders of a valid Continental Championship, annual or one event licence, or higher rank licence.

9. ENTRIES, ENTRY FEE

Application for entry must be made on the official UEM form included with these regulations. Applications must be approved by the rider's FMN and must reach the organiser no later than June 29th 2010. Normal Entry fee will be SEK 2550 and must accompany the official entry form. For entries received and accepted after June 29th and before July 22nd the late entry fee will be SEK 5100. **Please Note that No Entries will be accepted after July 22, 2010.** The Entry fee should be paid to postal giro (PG) 28 37 61-5 or credit card details should be included on the mandate form. Ticket allocation will be 10 per entrant. One ticket for the rider, 9 tickets for his crew and two vehicles passes for each entry. Please make sure to include your name address, class and start number on the Payment slip if paying via postal giro.

10. TECHNICAL INSPECTIONS

No rider or machine is permitted onto the drag strip unless he/it has passed the technical inspections, which will be held according to the following schedule:

12. REFUELLING

Refuelling must be done with utmost care. Disposing of oil and fuel leftovers must be deposited at a special place designated for that purpose. Non observance of any of these rules may result in exclusion from the event, or other penalty.

13. PADDOCK, PADDOCK SILENCE AND SPEED LIMIT

Paddock silence (no competition engines running) must be respected between 21.00 and 09.00 every night. Speed limit in the paddock is 10 km/h. Non observance of any one of these rules may result in exclusion from the event, or other penalty. An environmental mat, an oil absorption clothe, to place underneath the vehicle in the paddock/pit to prevent oil on the paving and to go in to the ground is mandatory. A fire extinguisher must be available, marked or placed clearly in sight in your pit area, in case of emergency.

14. OFFICIAL LANGUAGE OF THE MEETING

The official language of the meeting will be English.

15. PUBLICITY

The organiser reserves the rights to display publicity on the machines in accordance with article 60.7 of the UEM Sporting Code.

16. TRAVEL EXPENSES AND PRIZES

Prizes will be paid as follows per class:

Pro Stock Bike:	each qualified rider	EURO 495

The organiser will pay an additional minimum of €320 in travel compensation for foreigner competitors (riders who do not hold a licence in the event host country) who have qualified within the top ten for that class. To be eligible for prize money or Travel Expenses, each rider must pay a championship registration entry fee, of €600. The fee should be paid to the

promoter/Championship administrator 30 days before the first race.

17. PRIZE GIVING

A prize giving ceremony will take place in the start area at the soonest after the expiration of the protest time on Sunday, 1 August.

18. PROTESTS

All protests must be made in accordance with the requirements of the UEM Disciplinary and Arbitration Code and be accompanied by a deposit fee of €130 or equivalent in Swedish Kronor.

19. INSURANCE

By endorsing the application form for entry the FMN of the rider certifies that the rider is insured in accordance with the UEM requirements. Third party insurance in respect of riders covering accidents occurring during the meeting including qualifications will be the responsibility of the organiser.

The organiser disclaims all responsibility for damage to a motorcycle, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other cases.

20. RENUNCIATION OF ANY RECOURSE AGAINST SPORTING AUTHORITIES

Apart from the requirements of the UEM Sporting code riders by participating renounce all rights of appeal against the organiser, his representatives or agents by arbitration or before a tribunal or any other manner not foreseen by the FIM Sporting Code for damages for which they could be liable in consequence of all acts or omissions on the part of the organiser, his officials, representatives or agents in the application of these regulations or contributed to or arising out of their actions.

21. CONFIRMATION OF ACCEPTED ENTRY

TO BE SIGNED BY RIDER & ENTRANT

DECLARATION

I, the undersigned, apply to enter the event described above and enclose the appropriate fee and in consideration thereof:-

A) Responsibility. The participants (entrants, drivers, passengers, owners and owner-drivers of vehicles) take part in the event at their own risk. They bear the sole responsibility regarding civil and penal codes for damage caused by them or the vehicle in their use in so far as no liability exemption has been stipulated in compliance with the supplementary regulations of the meeting. If the driver, himself, is neither the owner nor the owner-driver of the vehicle used by him during the competition, he releases those persons listed in the following liability waiver from all claims by the owner and the owner-driver of the vehicle or submits, together with the entry form, a corresponding waiver from the owner or the owner-driver of the vehicle.

B) Liability waiver: By submitting the entry form, the participants (entrants, drivers, passengers, owners and owner-drivers of vehicles) waive all rights to legal action and recourse for any accident or damage incurred in conjunction with the event against:

- The UEM, the FIM, the SVEMO, their presidents, members, employees and officials:
- Member-clubs of the FMNR and their sub organisations:
- The organisers, promoters, his/their representatives, employees, stewards and assistants:
- The owner(s) of the property used for the event including structures and installations on it, the administration of the circuit used for the event, its representatives and assistants.
- The participants and their attendants as well as against his/her own assistance in so far as a race or special tests for attaining high-speed or best times are concerned.
- Authorities, race service and any other organisation or corporate or natural bodies involved in the organisation of the event.

In so far as the accident or damage did not occur through intent or gross negligence. This agreement will take effect for all parties involved with the submission of the entry form to the organiser.

1. I confirm that I understand the nature and type of events and the risk inherent with the sport and agree to accept the same notwithstanding that such risks may involve negligence on the part of the organisers/officials.
2. I further agree that I shall not seek to claim against the SVEMO, the organisers nor their officials, the landowners, the promoter(s) or other bodies or individuals connected with the event in respect of any damage to my property howsoever caused, and whether by negligence or breach of statutory duty of the said bodies or persons.
3. I further agree that the machine which I enter and compete on shall be suitable and proper for its purpose and that it will comply with the regulations in respect thereof, and it described above.
4. I understand and agree that I am required as soon as possible after arrival at the venue to register my arrival and sign on at the race office of designated area.
5. I declare that all Customs & Excise and/or Inland Revenue duties due on all fuel used during the event have been paid.

The undersigned recognises the above restrictions and commits himself to comply strictly with them. If an injury occurs or is noticed during the event or if the riders health has been effected such that his fitness for continuing in the motorcycling competition has been put in question, the undersigned - with regard to the security risk also resulting for third parties - releases the doctors in attendance from their obligation to professional secrecy towards the FMNR and towards the officials carrying responsibility at the event (Doctor of the event, clerk of the course, sporting stewards) respectively.

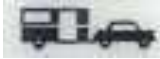
PIT SPACE FORM
